



2008 - 2009 Dress Code

Daily wear – Girls

PreK – 5 ----- PreK./Kind. Navy Logo Polo Dress
Plaid jumper, shorts or skirt
Navy or khaki slacks, shorts or skirts.
All shorts and slacks must be appropriate size.
Navy, white, or red (school logo) knit polo-style short sleeve golf shirt
Navy, white, or red (school logo) knit polo-style long sleeve golf shirt
SEA logo navy or red sweatshirt

Daily wear – Boys

PreK – 5 ----- Navy or Khaki shorts or slacks
All shorts and slacks must be appropriate size.
Navy, white, or red (school logo) knit polo-style short sleeve golf shirt
Navy, white, or red (school logo) knit polo-style long sleeve golf shirt
SEA logo navy or red sweatshirt

Cold Weather Attire – Boys and Girls

Navy or Khaki slacks (Must have one pair of slacks for cold weather)
All shorts and slacks must be appropriate size
Long-sleeved SEA logo golf polo shirt or turtleneck (red, white, or navy)
SEA logo sweatshirts
If the weather is too cold for just SEA sweatshirt an over jacket is allowed
(the only non uniform – item permitted)

Spirit Day Attire – Boys and Girls (SEA Spirit Days once a month)

Spirit T – shirts may be worn accompanied by uniform shorts or pants.

Footwear – Boys and Girls

White, black, or blue low-cut tennis shoes with white crew socks (Socks must be visible)

Belts – Boys and Girls - All students must wear belts and keep shirts tucked in.

P.E. Uniforms -Students will not change clothing for P.E. class except for swimming and canoeing classes. For swimming and canoeing, students will wear appropriate bathing suits of their choice. No two piece suits are allowed.

Please help us by ensuring your child adheres to the dress, hair style and jewelry parameters set forth in the handbook.

1. Verbal warning from teacher
2. Written notice or phone call from office
3. Parent called. Child will be sent to office and not allowed back in classroom until they comply with the dress code.
